- Important facts, data, and case studies
- Any recent updates/news/events related to the topic (if applicable)
- Analysis/Application Slide:
- How the concepts relate to real life/current events/environment
- One personal reflection or observation, if any

Conclusion Slide:

- Summary of important points
- Takeaways or lessons learned

Bibliography Slide:

List of books, websites, or other sources used (if any)

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

- Speak clearly and confidently.
- Use bullet points, not long paragraphs.
- Do not read directly from the slides—explain in your own words.
- Make eye contact with the class.
- Engage your audience—ask a question or include a fun fact.

DESIGN TIPS:

- Use legible fonts and clear headings.
- Stick to 1-2 background colors and 2-3 fonts for a neat look.
- Use relevant images and maps.
- Avoid overcrowding slides—keep text minimal and focused.
