Subject: Implementation of HPV Vaccination Campaign for Eligible Girl Students (14–15 Years)

Dear Parents

This is to inform you that the Directorate of Education, Government of NCT of Delhi, in collaboration with the Health & Family Welfare Department, has launched an HPV Vaccination Campaign to prevent cervical cancer among adolescent girls.

Under this initiative, a single dose of the HPV vaccine will be administered free of cost to all eligible girl students aged 14–15 years over a period of three months. The vaccination will be conducted at designated Government Health Facilities by trained medical teams and recorded on the U-WIN portal.

Since most beneficiaries fall within the school-going age group, the school will coordinate with the concerned health authorities to facilitate the vaccination process as per the session plan. You will be informed in advance regarding the date, time, and venue of the vaccination.

Parents are requested to:

- Carefully read the information shared regarding HPV vaccination.
- Fill and sign the consent form sent through your ward.
- Ensure that the hard copy of the consent form is submitted to the school by April 07, 2026.
- Make sure your ward is available on the scheduled date for vaccination.

Please note that submission of the consent form is mandatory for your child to receive the vaccine. All records will be maintained by the school as per government guidelines.

This vaccination plays a crucial role in protecting against cervical cancer and ensuring the long-term health of your child. We request your full cooperation in making this campaign successful.

CIRCULAR

Subject: Support for implementation of HPV Vaccination Campaign for eligible girl students (14–15 years) in NCT of Delhi.

Please find enclosed herewith D.O.No.15978 dated: 06.03.2026 received from Secretary Health and Family Welfare, regarding HPV Vaccination.

In this regard, all Heads of Government, Government Aided and Recognized Private Schools under Directorate of Education are hereby informed that the Health & Family Welfare Department, GNCTD has launched an HPV Vaccination Campaign to prevent Cervical Cancer among adolescent girls.

Under the campaign, one dose of HPV vaccine will be administered to all eligible girls in the age group of 14–15 years in NCT of Delhi over a period of three months. The vaccination will be conducted at designated Government Health Facilities by trained vaccination teams and recorded on the U-WIN Portal.

Since a majority of girls in this age group are school-going, schools are requested to extend full cooperation in successful implementation of the campaign.


Accordingly, all Heads of Schools are directed to undertake the following actions:

1. Nominate a Nodal Teacher (preferably TGT N. Sc.) for coordination of activities related to the HPV Vaccination Campaign.
2. Prepare a line list of all eligible girls aged 14–15 years studying in the school in the prescribed format. List of all eligible girl students as per given age category must be mailed to District Immunization Officers (DIOs) by 25th March, 2026. (attached herewith). **(list attached)**
3. Ensure that the School Nodal Teacher coordinates with the concerned District Immunization Officer (DIO) and School Health Scheme District Nodal Officer for mobilization of eligible students to the designated vaccination site as per the session plan.
4. Disseminate information regarding HPV vaccination among parents and students through school assemblies, WhatsApp groups and other appropriate communication channels.

5. Circulate and collect consent forms from parents/guardians of eligible girls and ensure that the signed consent forms are available during the vaccination session. Consent forms must be taken in hard copy and kept in safe custody by Heads of Schools.

All Heads of Government, Government Aided and Recognized Private Schools under Directorate of Education shall ensure timely compliance and extend full cooperation to the Health Department for the successful implementation of the HPV Vaccination Campaign and maintain proper record of students who shall be vaccinated.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
